ATTENDANCE MECHANISM

To be eligible for the End Semester Examinations, every student must secure a minimum of 75% attendance in each subject, counted individually for both theory and practical sessions.

- **Upload:** Submit scanned documents and a passport size photo, then accept the Terms of Declaration to proceed for verification by the admission cell.
