Husbands who promote physical violence feel that they are exercising a right controlling their wives and maintaining order in the family. Violence not only causes physical injury it also affects the social, economic, psychological, spiritual and emotional state of the victims. It has serious consequences on women's mental and physical wealth including their reproductive and sexual health causing injuries, gynecological problems, temporary or permanent disabilities, depression and suicide amongst others. Over time, women's physical injuries and mental pressure either interferes or ends their educational and career paths leading to increased illiteracy, poverty and economic dependance. Even the children of the family are severely affected and lose trust in the family if divorce or separation occurs between the couples. Children and teens who grow up seeing domestic violence in the household are more likely to use violence at school or community, attempt suicide, get addicted to drugs, commit crimes and many more.

Leaving an abusive relationship is of course challenging both emotionally and practically. The process involves realizing the occurring abuse, looking for support to leave safely and overcoming the painful experience. There are provisions by the government like protection of women from domestic violence Act 2005 that deals with cruelty by husband or his relative and the imprisonment upto three years. It is essential to recognize the signs of domestic violence and report the abuser if it is happening to you or around you. Nowadays domestic violence cases are also prevalent amongst men in the society. Government should take strict actions against domestic violence cases.
